






Surface Analysis Forecast for This Afternoon and Evening




Severe Weather Outlook for Today




Tornado Probabilities




Damaging Wind Probabilities

Timing of Severe Storms for Today




Forecast Concerns and Specifics


Today – A line of thunderstorms over middle Tennessee and Kentucky will move east southeast into our area by late this afternoon. Damaging winds up to 70 mph and large hail up to Golfball size are the main concern. Isolated Tornadoes are possible...mainly along and west of interstate 75.

Rainfall locally up to 1 inch.


Surface Analysis Forecast for Friday Night
