The applicant shows the ability to maintain CDBG/HOME funds regulatory compliance.</li> <li>2. If previously funded: the applicant has a strong record in managing previous CDBG/HOME funds and maintaining regulatory compliance. This includes, but is not limited to: meeting proposed goals, submitting quarterly report information on time, and addressing monitoring findings in a timely manner.</li> <li>3. Applicant has existing administrative and financial capacity to implement/continue proposed project/activity. Agencies not funded in prior three years will be required to submit audits.</li> <li>4. Agency has prepared a sustainability plan addressing how agency will continue to function without CDBG/HOME funds.</li> <li>5. | <p><b>Discretionary Assessment</b></p> <p>Each review committee member has a total number of discretionary points equal to the total number of applicants times 5 to award at their discretion. (5 total applicants translates to 25 total discretionary points available to committee member.) Committee members may award points to applicants providing a unique service in terms of type, need, location, resident make-up, urgency, or other criteria not specifically addressed in other elements.
