

Flashing Yellow Arrows

To improve safety, the City of Kingsport Traffic Engineering Division is placing flashing yellow arrow left-turn signal lights at intersections around the city. Most of these intersections previously used the standard circular green signal lights. Both types of signal lights direct motorists to turn **left after yielding to oncoming traffic**.

HERE'S HOW IT WORKS

Drivers will see one of the following lights as they approach a flashing yellow arrow display



Steady Red Arrow
Drivers turning left must stop and wait.



Steady Yellow Arrow
Drivers are warned the left turn signal is about to turn red. Do not enter the intersection if you can stop safely. Vehicles in the intersection should complete their turns.



Flashing Yellow Arrow
Drivers are allowed to turn left after yielding to oncoming traffic and pedestrians. (Oncoming traffic has a green light.) Drivers must determine if there is an adequate gap before turning!



Steady Green Arrow
Drivers making a left turn have the right of way. This sequence may be skipped if no left turning vehicles are detected by the signal system.


IN SUMMARY



Steady Red Arrow
Drivers turning left must stop and wait



Steady Yellow Arrow
Stop, if you can do so
⇒⇒⇒



Flashing Yellow Arrow
Proceed with left turn after yielding to oncoming traffic and pedestrians.



Steady Green Arrow
Proceed with left turn.
