4. Annual List of Priority Projects (Vote Required)

Presenter: Lesley Phillips & TDOT Representative(s)

Item Summary: Annually, the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) requests our input on TDOT sponsored transportation projects in the Kingsport MTPO area to be included in TDOT's Three-Year Work Program. These major projects are managed by TDOT and have traditionally been funded with TDOT resources that are available to the state, whether it be federal or state funds.

TDOT has provided a list of projects under consideration for the Three-Year Work Program. TDOT also allows us to add projects for consideration. These are state projects, not local projects. On the attached listing, the top table shows the projects TDOT has asked us to rank. The bottom table shows the projects we have added for consideration. The Kingsport MTPO staff proposes the rankings on the attachment (the rankings are shown in the last column). For informational purposes, the 2020 rankings are also shown. TDOT projects are ranked 1 through 6. The projects we added are ranked 7 through 11. The proposed rankings were emailed to Executive Board members and Technical Coordinating

Committee members on October 22 for review/feedback. The Executive Board can choose to accept the proposed rankings or alter them.

Recommendation: Approve the Resolution and project rankings as presented.

5. Annual Federal Funds Obligation Reports – Tennessee and Virginia

Item Summary: Per 23 CFR 450.334, annually the Kingsport MTPO is required to publish a list of federal funds (FHWA and FTA) that have been obligated on projects within the MTPO area for the previous fiscal year. The list must be made available within 90 days from the end of the program year (September 30). As outlined in the Kingsport MTPO Public Participation Plan, this information is published online and is also available for public review in the Kingsport MTPO office. Questions on individual projects can be answered by TDOT officials or VDOT officials. No Board action is required.

- I. **Call to Order:** Chairman Paul Montgomery called the meeting to order.
- II. **General Information/Attendance Roll Call:**
The meeting was held in-person with optional live public access available via Zoom Webinar. A video/audio recording of the meeting was published online at <https://www.kingsporttn.gov/city-services/kmtpo/meetings-notice/agenda-minutes/>

Attendance and votes were taken by roll call.
- III. **Public Comment:** Paul Montgomery invited members of the public to address comments related to agenda items. No comments.
- IV. **Approval of Minutes:** The minutes of the August 5, 2021 meeting were reviewed. No corrections and/or additions were suggested. A motion was made by Jimmy Adkins to approve the minutes and was seconded by Ronda Sawyer. Passed in a roll call vote: Adkins, Milner, Montgomery, Osborne, Sawyer, and Torbett voting “Aye”.

V. New Business:

- A. Amendment No. 1 to FY 20-21 Unified Planning Work Program.** Presented by Bill Albright. The Fiscal Years 20-21 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) includes funds to cover the cost of a consultant contract to develop the MPO-Area Long-Range Transportation Plan, which is updated every 5 years. The dollar amounts are included in the UPWPs budget tables under “Task E” and also the summary tables. The majority of these funds come from the Federal Highway Administration, with matching dollars from the City of Kingsport and TDOT. Virginia DOT also provides some funding as well. A funding contract with TDOT is executed every 3 to 5 years to provide the aforementioned federal highway dollars for all of the MPO expenses, including staff salaries, non-personnel expenses, and consultant work. Most years a reserve balance is left after expenses are incurred, making these dollars available for additional expenses (if needed). The 2021 UPWP had an estimated amount of funds programmed for LRTP expenses before the consultant contract was established and, therefore, it was anticipated that an amendment may be required to adjust (increase) the funding level. Amendment Number 1 adds dollars from the reserve amount to meet the contractual needs and also provide additional funds for staff time spent on the long-range plan and other tasks. A motion was made by Ronda Sawyer to approve Amendment No. 1 to the FY 20-21 Unified Planning Work Program and was seconded by Ambre Torbett. Passed in a roll call vote: Adkins, Milner, Montgomery, Osborne, Sawyer, and Torbett voting “Aye”. The motion carried unanimously.
- B. Amendment No. 7 to FY 20-23 Transportation Improvement Program.** Presented by Lesley Phillips. Amendment No. 7 adds funding to the Main Street project in downtown Kingsport including \$50,000 STBG funds for the Design Phase, \$2,542,645 STBG funds for the Construction phase, and \$611,612 CRRSAA (Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act) funds for the Construction phase. Construction is expected to start on this project sometime in 2022. A motion was made by Ambre Torbett to approve Amendment No. 7 to the FY 20-23 Transportation Improvement Program and was seconded by Chase Milner. Passed in a roll call vote: Adkins, Milner, Montgomery, Osborne, Sawyer, and Torbett voting “Aye”. The motion carried unanimously.
- C. Kingsport Regional Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan.** Presented by Bill Albright and plan consultants. The consultants from Gresham Smith and IBI Group presented the Kingsport Regional Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan to the MTPO Executive Board and guests. In order to give additional time for localities and the public to review the draft plan, the vote was postponed to a future meeting.

VI. PROJECT UPDATES/STATE AND FEDERAL PARTNER UPDATES

Staff provided updates on projects as requested. State and Federal updates and information were provided by TDOT, VDOT, and FHWA representatives.

VII. PUBLIC COMMENTS: Members of the public were invited to address the Executive Board with issues related to transportation planning issues, activities, and/or projects that pertain to the Kingsport Metropolitan Transportation Planning Organization. No comments.

VIII. ADJOURNMENT: There being no other business, a motion was made by Ronda Sawyer to adjourn the meeting and was seconded by Ambre Torbett. The motion carried unanimously.

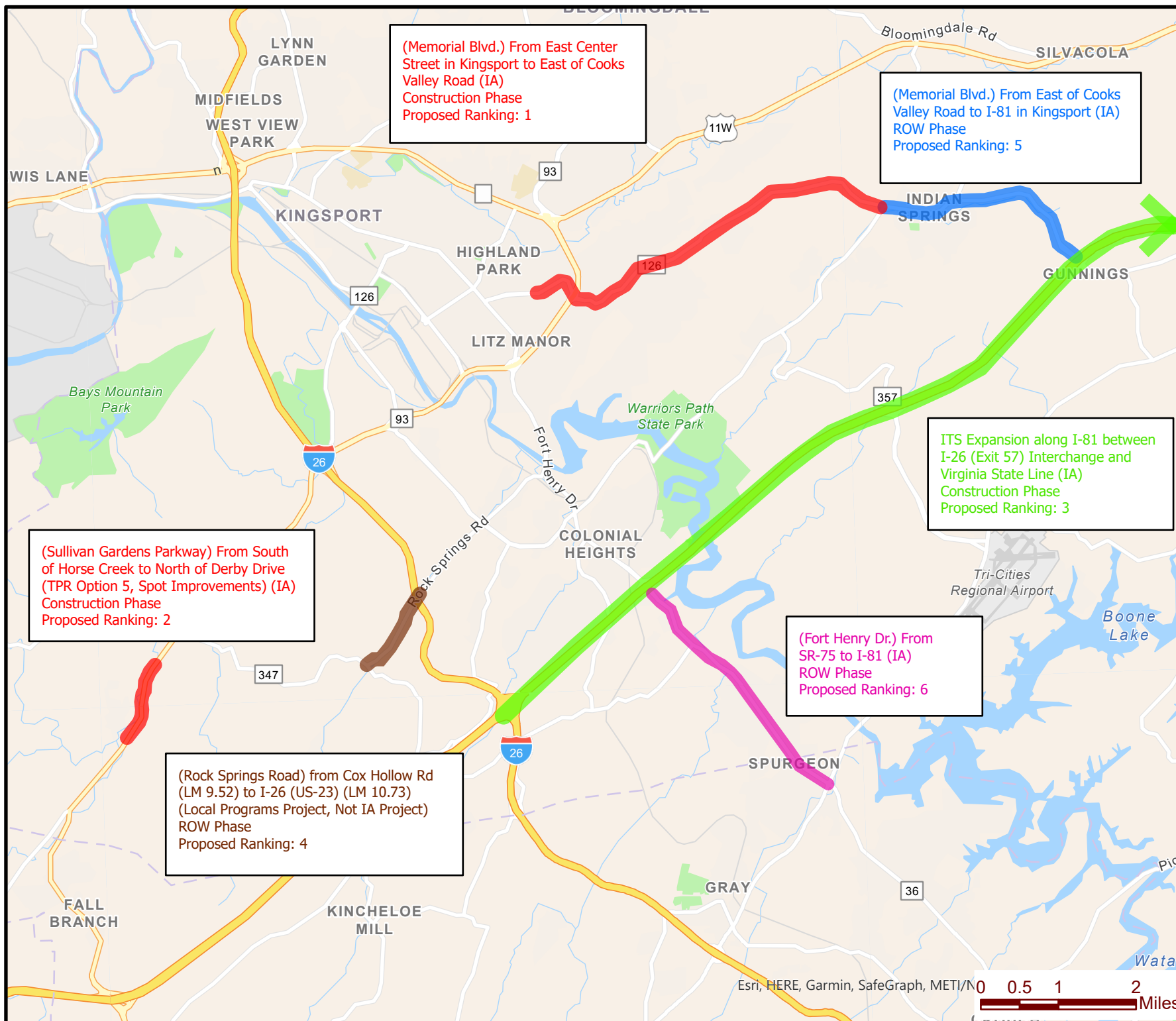
