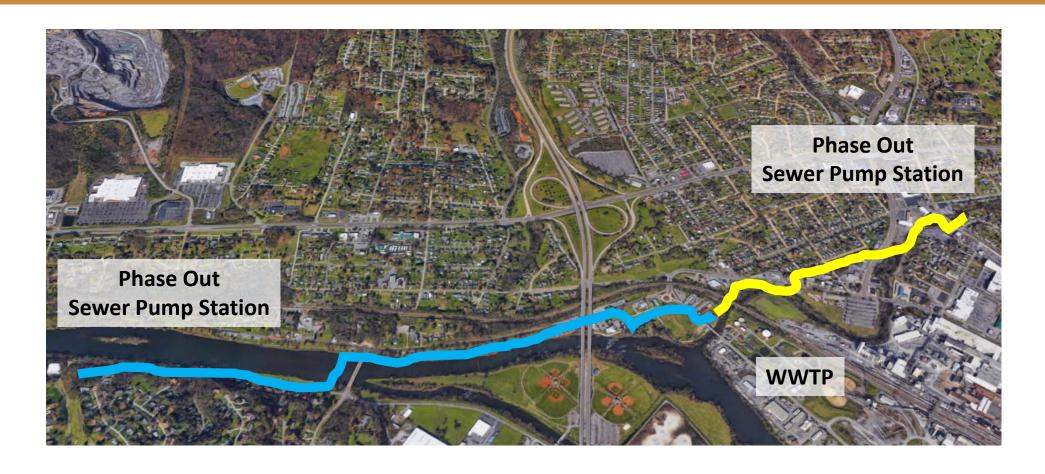

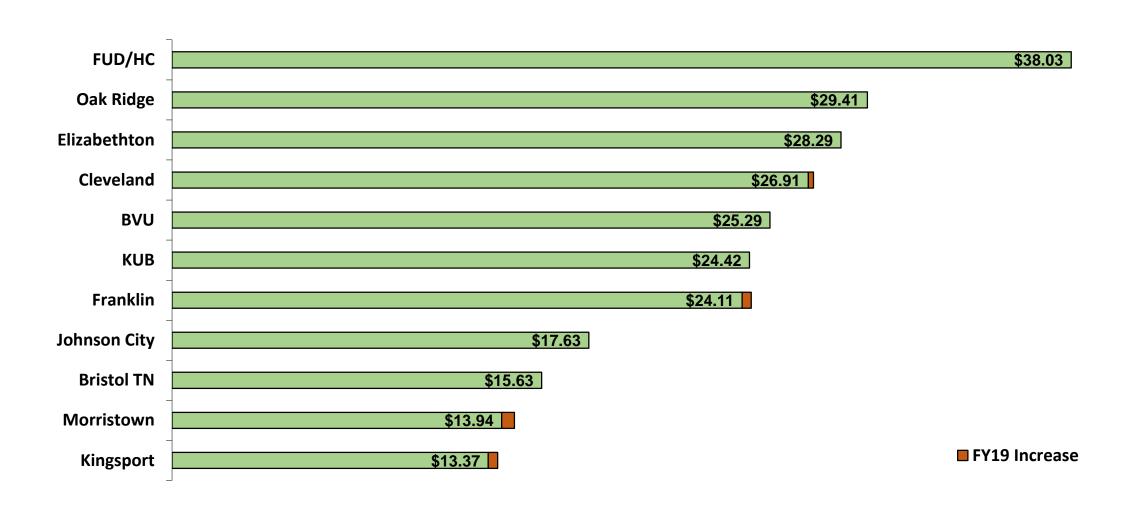

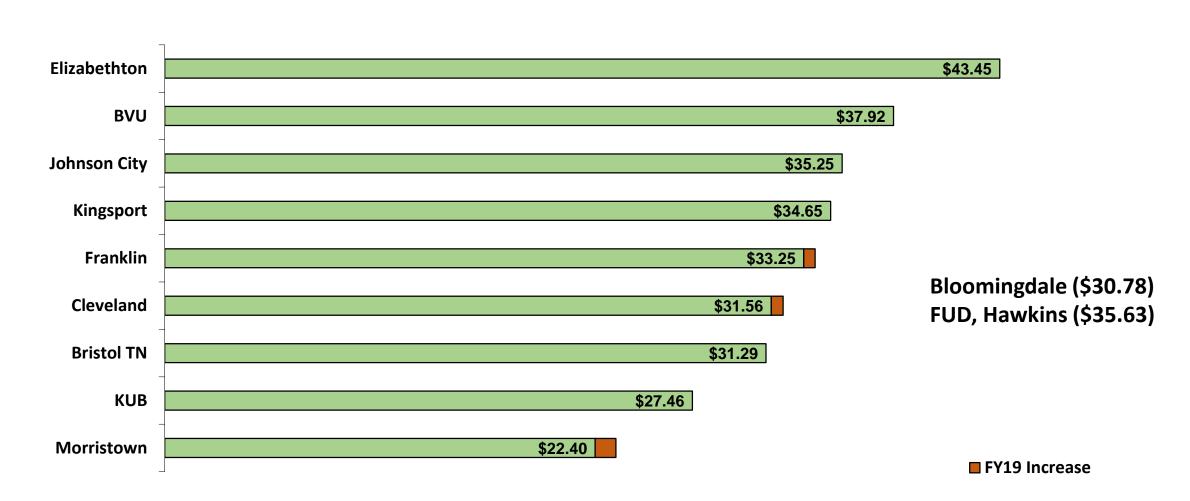


Average Water Bill for Typical Inside Residential Customer (3,600 gals)



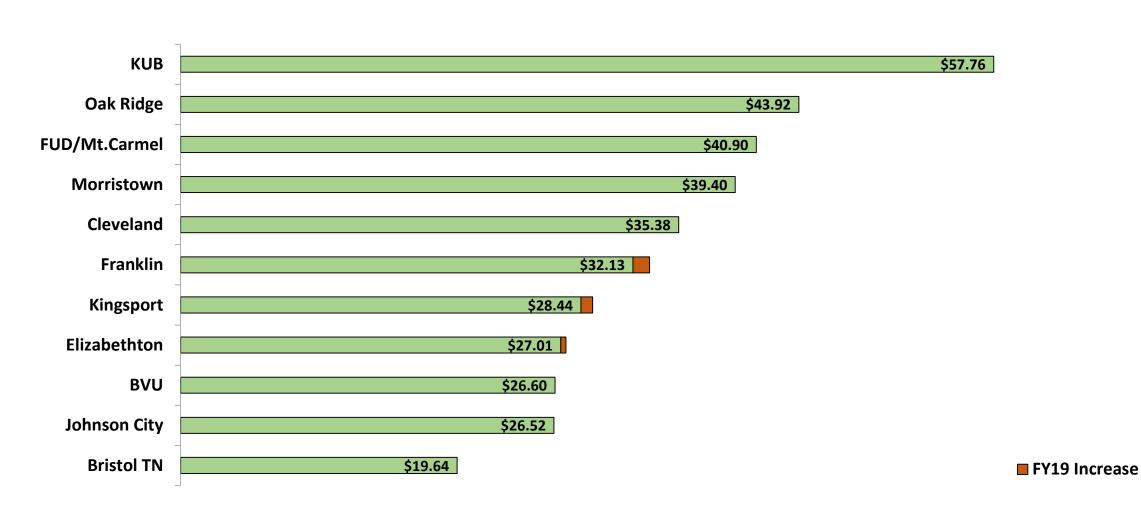


Average Water Bill for Typical Outside Residential Customer (3,600 gals)



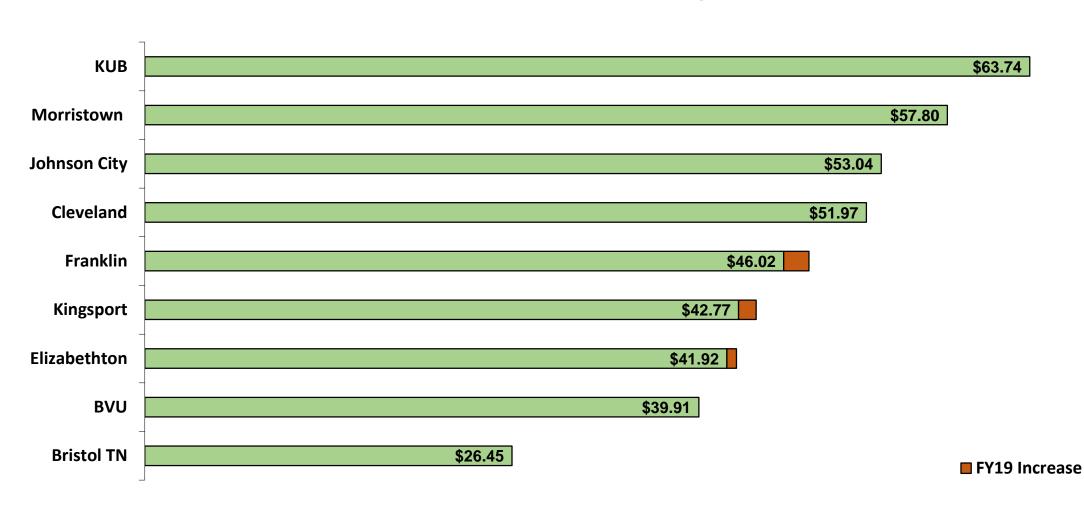


Average Sewer Bill for Typical Inside Residential Customer (3,600 gals)



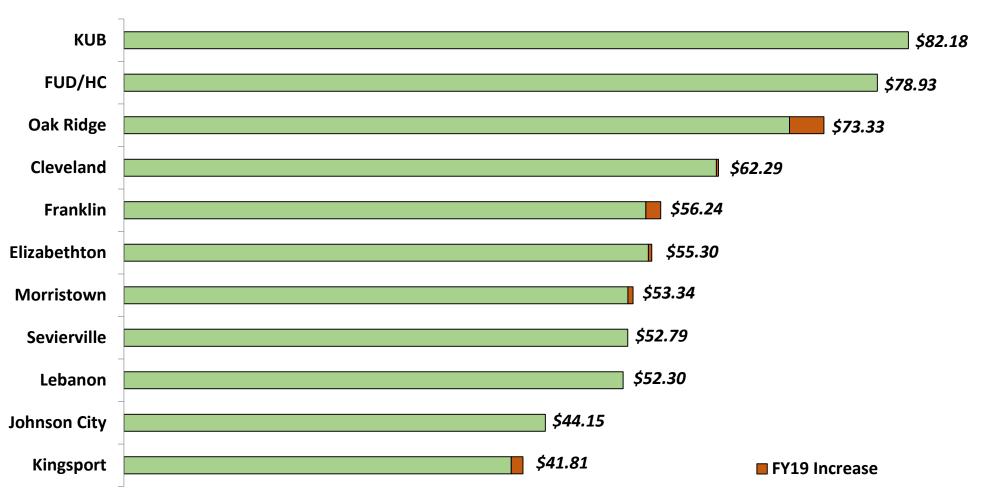


Average Sewer Bill for Typical Outside Residential Customer (3,600 gals)



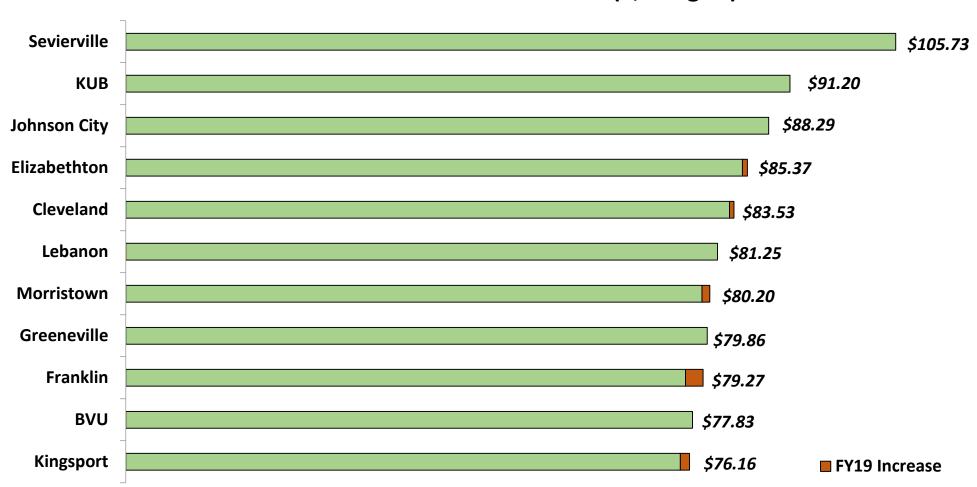


Average Combined Bill for Typical Inside Residential Customer (3,600 gals)

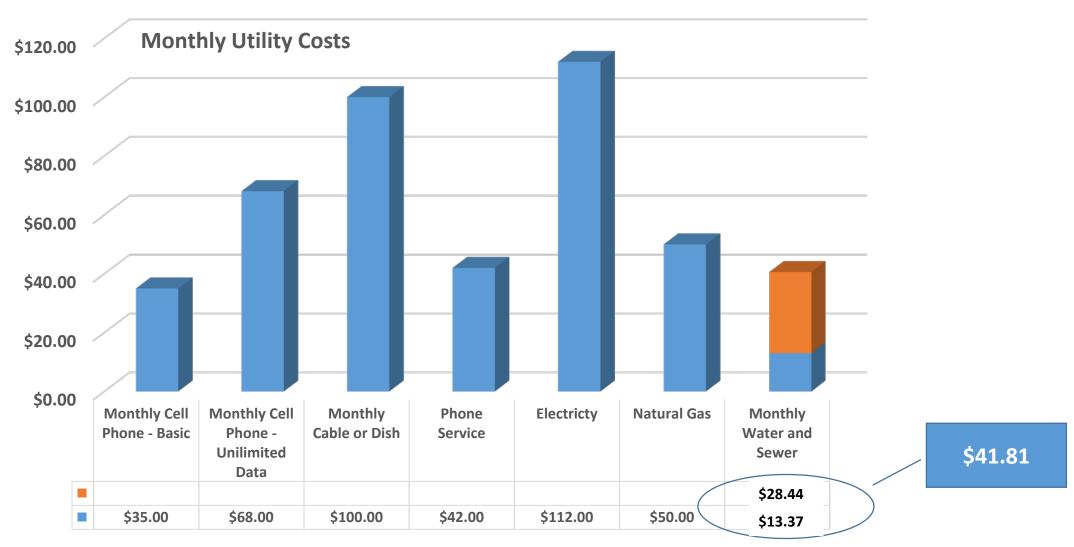




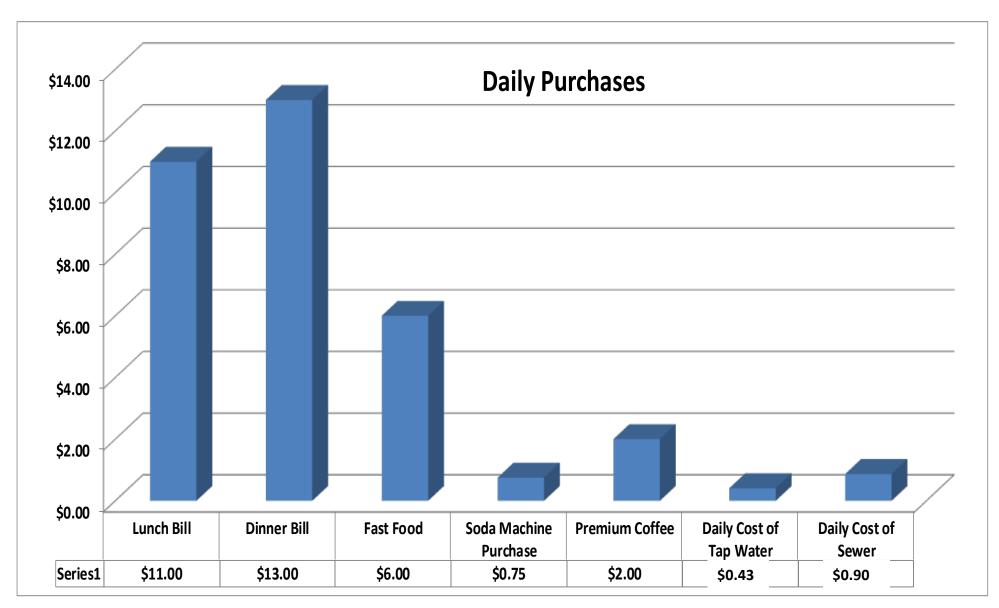
Average Combined Bill for Typical Outside Residential Customer (3,600 gals)





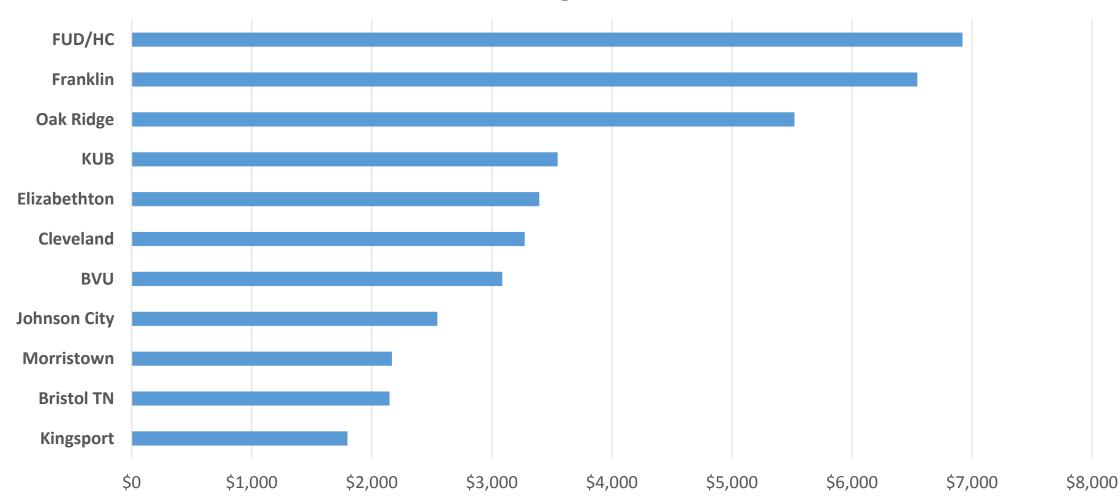
