## Please send your application no later than July 1st. Space is limited.

All applicants must submit a total of <u>5 current color photographs</u> along with their written application (good quality images suitable for promotional use). Photos will be kept. Your images must accurately represent your CURRENT work. Items not included in selection process may not be allowed in show. Trying a new item? Wonderful! © Just make sure to let us know! This protects both you and your neighbors, and helps us with booth placement. The Office of Cultural Arts reserves all rights to reject specific items from display.

Kingsport is recognized as an International Safe Community by the National Safety Council, a Healthier Tennessee community, and won the 2009 Harvard Innovations in American Government Award for its higher education initiatives. While many city names are duplicated throughout the U.S., there's only one Kingsport – a fact that invokes community pride, known locally as the "Kingsport Spirit."
