



MYKINGSPORT

MyKingsport is an easy way to learn information relevant to your residence within the city limits of Kingsport! All you have to do is navigate to the city's webpage at <https://www.kingsporttn.gov/> and find the tab that says MyKingsport. (Tip: It's the tab that's selected by default, so you shouldn't have to search too hard.)

Input your address, hit enter, and MyKingsport will find information for you about sanitation services, emergency services, political information, and location information. This is handy if your neighborhood has recently been annexed and you're not sure what that changes for you, if you're simply curious about where you live!

If MyKingsport returns “no address found” instead of the information like above, this mostly likely means that your residence is not within city limits.

The first column tells you what weekday your garbage and recycling will be collected, as well as when the next monthly yard waste removal will be. [Here's a page](#) on what the city will pick up on yard waste removal day.

The second column lists emergency services information: your responding police, fire, and EMS stations. If you have an emergency, please call 911.

The third column lists your Sullivan County Commissioner District, as well as your power and water providers. Remember, if you have Kingsport water, you can pay your bill online [right here](#).

The fourth column tells you what neighborhood you live in according to the city's official lines and what schools your home is zoned for.
